Adam's Angels Ministry Adopt-A-Family for Christmas Sponsor Guidelines

The purpose of the Adopt-A-Family program is to assist childhood cancer families during a time of great emotional crisis and/or financial need. These families are either coping with a child diagnosed with cancer, have a child survivor of cancer, or they have lost a child to cancer. To ensure that this is a rewarding and positive experience for both the families and the sponsors, we ask that you adhere to the following guidelines:

- To ensure that our families are adopted in time for the holiday season **please return your** "Sponsor Request Form List" as soon as possible.
- Sponsors wishing to purchase and deliver gifts for a family will be provided with a "Holiday Wish List" from their adopted family. When you receive your Adopt-A-Family "Holiday Wish List", we encourage you to call the family immediately and let them know that you are their sponsor.

Our guidelines suggest is a maximum of three (3) gifts totaling \$50 or less for each family member. This is totally your choice as a family if you decide to purchase more and exceed this suggested price. We ask that you try to keep the number of packages even for the children because they do count. A diagnosed child should not be singled out for more gifts. We might also suggest focusing on a family theme and providing holiday treats that all members of the family may enjoy together. Below is a list of popular gift ideas for your adopted family:

- "Holiday Wish List" items as requested on form.
- Clothing items: shoes, jackets, jeans, or pajamas.
- Gift certificates: from a grocery store for a holiday meal or a family-dining restaurant, from a clothing store, video store, a movie theater, zoo passes. Kids enjoy gift certificates from McDonalds, Chuck E. Cheese, Chick-Fil-A or other child friendly places.
- ✤ Gas cards help with the high cost of gas.
- Drug store cards help with over-the-counter medical supplies.
- Gifts for the adopted family are to be wrapped and delivered by sponsors from December 1st December 15th, unless arranged otherwise with the family.
- Sponsors are encouraged to purchase and deliver gifts to the families personally; however monetary donations are accepted as well. AAM Angel Helpers will shop, wrap and deliver the gifts to the families with monies received through monetary donations. Sponsors wishing to make monetary donations need only complete the applicable sections of the "Sponsor Request Form List" and mail it along with their donation to AAM at the address on the previous page.
